ARTSPRING FESTIVAL 2020

May 9 - June 7, 2020

This year, ArtSpring—the art festival that turns Prenzlauer Berg, Weißensee and Pankow into an open-air art gallery, with the aim of making the area's studios visible and open to the public—will take place mostly online. With digital readings, performances and podcasts, artists will give virtual insights into their studios, and the festival will present their magazine content online. The ArtSpring film festival—the artsrpingnale—screenings will be available online as well, in cooperation with Lichtblick-Kino. Additionally, an exhibition will be presented in the 7m-long shop window of Heinrich-Böll-Bibliothek.
